

Liaison Statement

To: BCAST and IOP-BRO Working Groups of the Open Mobile Alliance

In our earlier liaison statement dated 19 March 2007, we have informed OMA that we have created commercially focussed implementation profiles of the OMA BCAST 1.0 enabler, and have shared these profiles with OMA. In the meantime, we have made these profiles consistent with the revision of OMA BCAST from beginning of May 2007, without adding new functionality.

bmcoforum members held a test camp in Berlin from June 4-8, 2007, focussing on IOP testing implementations of the above-mentioned implementation profile. The test camp itself comprised some ten server and twelve client implementations and various test equipment from over 21 companies. Essential functions like the Electronic Service Guide as well as first implementations of Service Provisioning and the DRM and Smartcard profiles for Service and Content Protection have been tested.

The tests conducted at the test camp have demonstrated a promising level of interoperability. Currently, detailed evaluation and aggregation of the reports is taking place. As soon as the results are available, we will share our findings with you in a follow-up liaison statement, and provide feedback w.r.t. the OMA BCAST 1.0 specification if applicable.

bmcoforum plans to extend its first version of the implementation profiles of the OMA BCAST 1.0 enabler specification in the second half of 2007 aligned with the ongoing OMA work on maintenance and IOP testing of the BCAST 1.0 enabler release, extending the set of supported functionalities thereby enabling equipment vendors to provide and provision for commercial solutions commencing 2008. We are committed to define profiles entirely compliant with the OMA enabler release. Therefore we look forward to cooperate with OMA and its member companies to review the profiles to stay in sync with the OMA BCAST enabler release as the work progresses in OMA.

We are looking forward to a closer cooperation in the near future.
