### 1 Overview

OMA has recently approved their HTML5 Deployment Suite and OMA IOP would like to inform W3C of the current test case status.

### 2 Status

OMA IOP has this month finished their HTML5 Deployment Suite including the ETS specification (see link in [1]) and TFP (not referenced here) with a final review and was consequentially approved as Candidate. Features included are:

- Sections
- Grouping Content
- Text-Level Semantics
- Embedded Content
- Forms
- Interactive Elements
- Input Attributes
- Input Types

This Deployment Suite could be used by organisations like GCF or PTCRB for terminal testing certification and that way align testing efforts and expectations.

In another new Work Item Proposal we're currently suggesting to create another Deployment Suite in order to test CSS 3.0 features for the mobile industry.
