Dear OMA DRM Chairperson

As per our Liaison Agreement, CMLA is requesting you to include the following new requirements for OMA DRM it has captured from its adopters and founders.

1. Given current business developments, there is need to permit domain context to be distributed across more than one RI in order to support a worldwide central domain control authority. Recall, currently OMA DRM Domains are based on RI context.
 - a. Now there is a need to indicate to DRM agents as to whether or not the RI is part of a group of RIs supporting a particular Domain.
 - b. An RI that is part of such a domain could be indicated via the key purpose for the rights issuer's certificate. This would permit OMA DRM agents to discriminate between common domain control authorities and regular OMA RI Domains and act accordingly.
2. Given this requirement we request that OMA DRM add the Digital Entertainment Content Ecosystem (DECE) Common File Format as an optional OMA DRM DCF format.
3. Given that there are different formats for DRM protected content with some requiring more than one CEK, we also request to be able to permit more than one CEK to be distributed at one time via a Domain RO. Some OMA adopters believe this can be accomplished within the current specification however, we submit that it would be best if OMA DRM clarified that the CEK could contain one or more content keys.
