Re: 3GPP2 SC Actions Regarding 3GPP2/OMA Workshop

Dear Mark,

This correspondence is intended to advise you of 3GPP2 Steering Committee (SC) actions related to the 3GPP2/OMA Workshop that was held on 13 December 2004 in Maui, HI.

During the 3GPP2 SC meeting this week, the SC made the following decisions:

- The 3GPP2/OMA Workshop conclusions were endorsed by the 3GPP2 SC without objection. A copy of those conclusions has been attached for your reference.
- The TSG-S proposal for specific 3GPP2 processes that implement the 3GPP2/OMA Workshop conclusions was approved without objection for implementation within 3GPP2 and for transmission to OMA. A copy of those procedures has been included as an attachment to this letter.

Please note that these actions were based on the assumption of the 3GPP2 SC participants that the OMA TP will also be endorsing the workshop outputs and enacting specific OMA procedures that will codify those conclusions within OMA.

Based on these actions, the 3GPP2 SC requests the following actions from the OMA TP:

1. Please advise OMA status on the endorsement of the 3GPP2/OMA Workshop conclusions as well as the codification of those conclusions into OMA procedures.
2. During the workshop, OMA took two (2) actions, noted as follows:
 - a. Provide clarification of OMA Openness Policy.
 - b. Provide OMA response to IPR issues of concern that were identified during the workshop proceedings in terms of an OMA plan to change their policies and an OMA suggested work around plan to address 3GPP2 IPR concerns.


These open actions are based on substantial concerns within the 3GPP2 membership and we strongly request your prompt response.

3. As a part of the approval of the 3GPP2 procedures, several assumptions were made for complementary OMA actions that are listed in the attached procedures. For your reference, those complementary actions are summarized below:
 - a. On at least a quarterly basis, OMA shall send the following information to 3GPP2 TSG-S:
 - i. the current work program
 - ii. a list of the approved Work Items
 - iii. a list of draft/approved requirements documents
 - iv. a list of draft/approved reports and specifications
 - b. OMA agrees to work with 3GPP2 TSG-S to develop a terminology cross-reference to assist the correct interpretation of specification information.
 - c. OMA agrees to identify all OMA Enabler Releases dependent on 3GPP2 deliverables.
 - d. OMA agrees that, where overlap between planned work in 3GPP2 and OMA exists, the development TSG and appropriate OMA WG should identify the best way to minimize duplication of work and divide the development activities.
 - e. OMA agrees that, when a 3GPP2 TSG and OMA WG both interact with a common external group, the TSG and OMA WG should determine whether the relationship with the external group allows either the TSG or OMA WG to assume the role of lead contact, and if such a possibility exists, to establish the appropriate working relationships. The TSG should send the OMA WG a copy of any liaison addressed to the external group; likewise, the OMA WG should copy the TSG when it communicates with the external group.
 - f. OMA agrees that 3GPP2 and OMA should establish and publish a policy for cross referencing documents produced by the other organization.

3GPP2 requests immediate OMA commitment to these complementary actions.

Your prompt response to all actions is highly appreciated.
