In our previous liaison we indicated our intention to have a draft of ISMACryp 2.0 for public review as a result of our March meeting. This document is now available on [www.isma.tv](http://www.isma.tv) and we attach it to this liaison for your review. ISMACryp 2.0 incorporates ISMACryp 1.1 and extends it in important ways that are in line with your BCast specification. We consider this specification technically mature and ready for being referenced by other standard bodies. This draft is open for public comment until the end of June 2007, and your comments are appreciated.

As part of the 24<sup>th</sup> Forum we conducted interop tests for ISMACryp 2.0 and successfully tested interoperability between independent implementations of three companies.

We are planning for another plugfest in June/July 2007 (tentative date: July 12<sup>th</sup>+13<sup>th</sup>) to finalize interoperability tests and would welcome participation from OMA members. Would this be of interest to you and do you have any constraints for us to take into consideration?
