25 3GPP2 TSG-X would like to inform the OMA Location Working Group of the recent decisions
26 made toward the work on IP-Based Location Services. TSG-X has agreed to:
27

- 28 ▪ support the use of Roaming Location Protocol (RLP) defined by OMA, as a roaming
29 protocol,
30
- 31 ▪ support TCP/IP as the transport protocol for the interaction between the Target Mobile
32 Station and the Position Server (i.e., SUPL Location Platform).
33

34 In addition, it has been brought to our attention that RLP will need to be enhanced to
35 accommodate the needs of 3GPP2. We trust that decisions described in this correspondence will
36 assist in your efforts toward a timely completion of the OMA location specifications (RLP and
37 SUPL).
