1 Overview

As part of an ongoing analysis of OMA work, an analysis was performed on OMA specifications to determine dependencies on internal and external specifications.

2 Proposal

This Liaison is to provide 3GPP2 with a list of OMA's dependencies on 3GPP2's specifications, with the desire that 3GPP2 will review this list and provide OMA with any corrections or updates.

The table below lists the dependencies that OMA has against ongoing work in 3GPP2. The level of dependencies that can be determined is closely related to which stage of development that the corresponding work in OMA is in, e.g. meaning that in the early phases of the requirements work, no exact dependencies may have been identified.
