### Re: Response to OMA REL LS to 3GPP2 TSG-S on OMA Dependencies

3GPP2 TSG-S would like to thank the Release Planning and Management Committee of the OMA for providing periodic updates on the dependencies of OMA work on current work in 3GPP2.

Having reviewed the OMA REL LS titled "OMA dependencies on 3GPP2 deliverables and other work program related information" dated 5 November 2004, TSG-S would like to provide the following feedback relative to the table on pages 3 through 6.

- 3GPP2 specification version numbers are required to determine whether the appropriate 3GPP2 specifications are referenced.
- Several 3GPP2 documents that were previously published are now being held (i.e., "un-published" or removed from the 3GPP2 website) pending implementation of the OMA IPR policy change.
- The 3GPP2 document numbering convention identifies the responsible work group. For example, S.Rxxxx is a published TSG-S report, C.Pxxxx is a proposed TSG-C document, X.Sxxxx is a published TSG-X specification, and so forth. Thus, TSG-S is responsible for S.R0062 and S.R0062 has been published. And, regarding the 3GPP2 TSG/WG on Page 4 Row 1, TSG-X should be changed to TSG-C as the responsible group.
- 3GPP2 specification numbers should be referenced instead of the corresponding TIA standards numbers. For example, C.S0022-A v1.0 should replace TIA-801 relative to Location Services.
- TSG-S noticed some discrepancies relative a few 3GPP2 document names and numbers. For example, X.P0013.7 should be X.P0013-007.
- Documents X.S0013-007 v1.0 and X.S0013-002 v1.0 were published in February 2004 and document X.P0013-004 v2.0 is under development and has not been published, as yet.
- Note, 3GPP2 TSG-X has identified Location Services (LOC) as an item currently of mutual interest as opposed to an item with current dependencies. 3GPP2 will reassess dependency at a later date.
- Regarding Page 6 Row 1, the TSG-C contribution "C00-20040209- 119B\_S.P0079: "QoS Stage 1 v0.5.7" should be removed and replaced with the appropriate TSG-S Stage 1 document name and number.

To keep OMA informed of the status of recent 3GPP2 Work Items, requirements documents, and specifications with OMA dependencies, TSG-S is providing the attached "3GPP2-OMA Dependency

Report". TSG-S would like to request that the OMA REL review the attached "3GPP2-OMA Dependency Report" and provide any corrections or updates.

3GPP2 TSG-S looks forward to working closely with the OMA REL to coordinate and communicate relative to work items of mutual interest and dependency between our organizations.
